'Children come first'

Dear Parents,

We hope you enjoyed the half term break. You are probably already aware that due to increase cases of covid in Wales, the Welsh Government changed the rules on self-isolation from 29th October.

Staff and pupils will now need to self-isolate if they have symptoms or there is someone else in their household who has symptoms or is positive.

This applies to everyone, even those adults who are double vaccinated. This rule only applies to close contact within the household.

If someone is double vaccinated, or between the ages 5-17, they must book a PCR test and isolate until the result is known. If this is negative, they can carry on as normal and return to school. You could choose to take another PCR test 6 days after your first if you wanted to.

If someone isn't fully vaccinated, they must isolate for 10 days and take a PCR test on Day 2 and Day 8.

If your child is under 5 they do not need to isolate or take a PCR test if they have a close contact within the household or otherwise however if they have any of the symptoms they must stay home until they are well. You can still choose for them to take a PCR if this would provide you with peace of mind. Please be aware our under 5 pupils are in the same class with our over 5 pupils.

If you have had contact with someone outside of your household who has tested positive, you will be contacted by TTP and advised to take a PCR test on the 2nd and 8th Day but you only need to isolate if your results are positive.

Lateral Flow tests are only to be taken if you have NO symptoms. A PCR test must be taken if you have any of the 3 main covid symptoms – a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss or change to taste or smell. You can order LTF's online or collect for free from the local library.
