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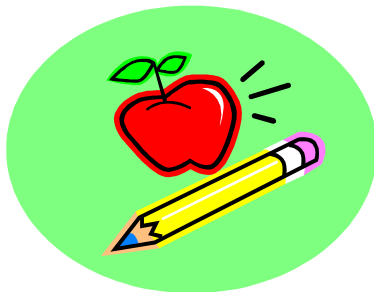
Information leaflet

Behaviour

Throughout the whole school we use the 'Good to be Green behaviour system'

GOOD BEHAVIOUR - Correct behaviour and effort are rewarded with merit points, certificates, stickers, praise and a pool party at the end of the academic year for the winning house.

The process for negative behaviour works in stages where the consequences become more severe should negative behaviour continue. The first consequence is a warning for the pupil who has been misbehaving, this results in their



green card being turned to a vertical position. The second consequence is a yellow warning card placed horizontally, this means they do not get to stand in merit service and lose some of their good to be green play on a Friday. The next stage is the yellow card placed vertically; pupils will lose some of their next play and be asked to take a short time-out. The final consequence is a red card, this means being sent to the head teacher and a letter will be sent home. A behaviour log is completed with the pupil if we get to this stage. Certain behaviours go straight to red.

Reading Records

Reading records show your child's progress in reading. They should be brought to school every day. Your child is expected to do some reading practice in their own time each day. This book will also record weekly spellings to learn. Many of your child's internet login details are placed at the front of their records in order for them to access sites such as RM Easimaths and TT Rockstars at home.

Times tables

Your child will be regularly tested on times tables appropriate to their ability level.

Your child has their own times tables practice card which can be used to revise their times tables at home. Each pupil has a times table achievement card and when they achieve thirty out of thirty in their times table test, they will be given a sticker and progress to the next table.

We are continuing to use BBC Supermovers, TT Rockstars and TT Blast to help us learn our times tables.
