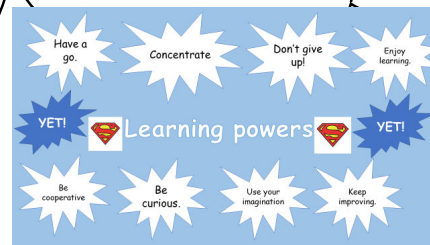
I often work with my "**talking partner**". We share our ideas; plan our work and reflect on our learning together. This helps us both. My learning partner maybe different in different topics and lessons, we change partners regularly and they're chosen randomly

In lessons we decide on **Success Criteria**. This helps me know how I can be successful in my learning and how to make my work even better.



Learning can happen **inside and outside** of the classroom. Sometimes I might go to different parts of the school to learn, or even to the park! We also go on educational visits throughout the year. All this helps reinforce my learning, we can all learn in different ways and through different activities.

We are encouraged to apply our learning powers like; being **curious; resilient, cooperative, imaginative and creative** whilst having **fun** and **applying ourselves to tasks**.



Our teachers give us verbal feedback too. This means they tell us important things about our work during the task. This really helps us as the feedback is on the spot and helps us straight away!



A **visualizer** is a special kind of projector. My teacher uses this to show and share my work to the class and to model examples.
