HEADLICE

Checking for head lice shouldn't be considered a big deal; it is just a normal
part of a family's personal hygiene routine like brushing teeth or washing
hair.
☐ It is best to check for head lice using a comb made for the purpose, ideally
white so they can be easily seen and with teeth no more than 0.3mm apart in
order to trap head lice
☐ Combing through the hair when wet, or after applying a conditioner, may
make the process more comfortable
☐ Good lighting is important and so is comfort
Treatment should only be applied if a living, moving louse is found – never
'just in case'
Continue to check for head lice on a regular, weekly basis – ONCE A
