HEADLICE

Don't forget this term to continue to remember to check your child's hair once a week for headlice.

Headlice don't jump or fly they walk from hair strand to hair strand so please remind your child not to place their head next to others. It only takes one family not to check, for head lice, so if everyone gets into the routine of checking weekly it should vastly reduce the issue.

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☐ It is best to check for head lice using a comb made for the purpose, ideally
white so they can be easily seen and with teeth no more than 0.3mm apart in
order to trap head lice
□ Combing through the hair when wet, or after applying a conditioner, may
make the process more comfortable
☐ Good lighting is important and so is comfort
Treatment should only be applied if a living, moving louse is found – never
'just in case'
