SECONDARY ADMISSION

Parents of year 6 pupils can now apply for secondary September 2026 admissions through Denbighshire County Council website. **The closing date is 3rd November 2025.**

NURSERY & RECEPTION ADMISSION

Nursery and Reception applications for September 2026 admissions open from this **Monday 22nd September** through Denbighshire County Council website.

The closing date for Reception applications is **17th November 2025** – **those who have children in our current nursery class will need to apply now for Reception.**

The closing date for Nursery applications is **16th February 2025.**

Please remember to return the photo consent form and the data information form to school as soon as possible. Thank you to those who have returned. It is very important that we hold the correct contact details for parents.

NUT ALLERGY

Please be aware, we have a pupil at the school with a serious allergy to nuts and sesame seeds. Please help us to keep them safe by not sending any food items containing nuts or sesame seeds to school for their snack or in their lunch box. If your child eats any nuts/sesame seed before coming to school please ensure they have washed their hands and faces.

JEWELLERY/TOYS

As per the school uniform policy, we do not allow pupils to wear jewellery in school. The only exceptions to this rule are stud earrings in pierced ears, a small object of religious significance or medical significance and a watch. These items must be removed during PE/swimming lessons.
