### HEADLICE

Please remember to check your children's hair and all members of the family for head lice on a regularly basis and treat if live lice are found.

Checking for head lice shouldn't be considered a big deal; it is just a normal part of a family's personal hygiene routine like brushing teeth or washing hair.

 $\Box$  It is best to check for head lice using a comb made for the purpose, ideally white so they can be easily seen and with teeth no more than 0.3mm apart in order to trap head lice

□ Combing through the hair when wet, or after applying a conditioner, may make the process more comfortable

□ Good lighting is important and so is comfort

Treatment should only be applied if a living, moving louse is found – never 'just in case'. If you have to treat, don't forget to do again the following week and this includes all family members.
