



Our positive behaviour plan.

Our children are encouraged to develop positive and caring attitude towards themselves, each other and the community they live in.

We work together to create an environment where all are treated with respect, understanding and sensitivity.

We do this by having clear rules and rewards. We also use consequences so we can learn how to make good choices in the future.

We all follow the **Golden rules.....**

- ✓ Be kind and gentle
- ✓ Be polite and helpful
- ✓ Try our best
- ✓ Look after property
- ✓ Do good listening
- ✓ Be honest

We focus on the behaviour we DO want not what we don't want. We listen so we can understand the pupil's view and talk through situations so they are a learning experience.

Rewards

- *A smile, a nod, a thumbs up (non-verbal praise)
- *saying what we are proud of (verbal praise)
- *each class has their own merit points or merit marbles and display
- *stickers
- *postcard or text message home

*whole school good to be green play on a Friday

Consequences from good to be green cards

1. Green up – a verbal warning
2. Yellow – 3 minutes off golden time, 5 minutes off next play
3. Yellow up – 3 more minutes off golden time, 8 minutes off next play, 5-10 minutes time out if needed
4. Red – sent to Head or Deputy, lose all golden time. 10 minutes off next play. Parents informed.

Working together
