- ▶ Traffic can be dangerous if the driver is not concentrating or going too fast

▶ NEVER distract the driver.

▶ NEVER block the rear view mirror.

- ▶ IF POSSIBLE, get out on the pavement side.

- ▶ If you're sitting in the back seat, it's much safer to get out on the pavement side.
- ▶ If that's not possible, always remember to look out for passing cars and cyclists before opening the door.
