

School Uniform Gwisg Ysgol

The children's school uniform is:

- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo
- White or light blue polo shirt
- Grey, charcoal, black or navy school trousers (**leggings are not to be worn as part of the uniform**)
- Navy or Grey skirt or pinafore (**length to be on or below the knee**)
- Navy or light blue checked dress in the summer term
- White, grey, black or navy socks/tights
- Suitable flat black or navy shoes

- Plain (no logos) black/navy joggers or sport leggings and unexpensive trainers are **only** to be worn on PE or Swimming days

- On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are ear-ring studs only in pierced ears, a watch (no smart watches) and a small object of religious significance, (such as a crucifix on a chain) or medical significance.

- No make up or painted nails/false nails to be worn by pupils.

The logo on our uniform is of 'Caer Drewyn'
